QUESTIONS

- Opening Scripture: Ephesians 5:15
 - What does it mean to live carefully and wisely in today's world?
 - What are some ways we can evaluate our lives and avoid foolishness?
 - Wisdom is not just about age or experience but about evaluated experience. What does it look like to evaluate your experiences and learn from them?
- How does living in light of eternity help you make better decisions? What are some areas of your life where you need to connect today's actions with tomorrow's consequences?
- What are the "big picture" priorities that guide your decisions? How does focusing on eternal values impact your everyday life?
- This week, identify one area where you need to practice wisdom by evaluating past decisions or seeking God's guidance for the future. Share it with the group.
