- 2. When you think about this scene, do you think that you would have the same thought as the Pharisee about the woman being so close to Jesus?

- 2. What do you do if you are trying everything you can to just follow God and stay away from the people who are far from God? Is it okay to just be at a point in your life where healthy means staying away from people who want to get you to stop following Jesus?
- 3. Where do you think God is pushing you to be more open to people who are far from God?
