Key Scripture

Hosea 3:1-5

Open

- 1. Is there a person you had to forgive and was it hard to forgive them?
- 2. Is there someone you have chosen not to forgive? Tell us about that.
- 3. Does it sometimes feel better to hold onto bitterness than to forgive?

Dig

- 1. As a group read Hosea 3:1-5 why would people tremble at the goodness of God in the long run? There is a symbolism of God's history with people in these verses. What are these verses symbolically pointing toward?
- 2. What is it about God's grace and forgiveness that makes it superior to bitterness and resentment? Why is it 'right' to forgive when it doesn't feel right?
- 3. Mark talked about how forgiveness doesn't mean that you have to start trusting someone again, tell us a story in your life where you have found that to be true.

Take Further

- 1. Why does Mark make a point to show us that forgiveness is not a feeling, it is a choice? What does that mean?
- 2. What did you think of Mark's definition of forgiveness as tearing up an "IOU?" Is there an IOU you need to tear up?
- 3. Name that thing or that person out loud and ask for the group to help you take the proper steps of forgiveness.
